This permission of the Board of Governors, Medical Council of India for establishment of new medical college and admission of students is initially for a period of one year. It will be renewed on yearly basis on verification of achievements of annual target set out in the project report. This process of annual renewal of permission will continue till such time the establishment of medical college and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per the norms of Medical Council of India.

- (iii) The admission process for the academic year 2013-14 has to be completed in accordance with the time schedule indicated in the Graduate Medical Education Regulation, 1997, as amended. No admission is permitted beyond the cut-off date.

It shall be incumbent upon the Medical College that the information relating to admissions should be submitted within a fortnight of closure of admissions to the Council. Any failure to submit the information within this time limit would be construed that the admissions in the College were not in accordance with the statutory requirements, thereby enabling the Council to proceed in accordance with law against the College.

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I am further directed to inform that you and your institution are fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty and clinical material, etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in Regulation of Medical Council of India. In case false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permission of the Board of Governors and the said misconduct is brought to notice or comes to the knowledge of MCI at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is not liable to be considered for renewal of permission for the next academic year and this letter of permission is also liable to be revoked for current academic year. 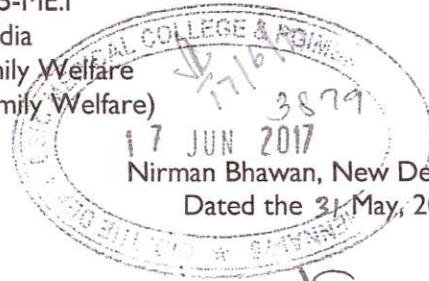

8 (3) ...

(2) The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed.

(3) The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition.

(4) Failure to seek timely renewal of recognition as required in sub-clause (a) supra shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute."

In view of above, you are, therefore, requested to issue necessary notification at the earliest recognizing ESIC Medical College, Chennai, Tamilnadu for the award of MBBS degree when granted on or after Feb., 2018 by The Tamilnadu Dr. M G R Medical University Chennai.

The report of virtual assessment is not available with UGMEB. The physical verification report was considered in the Undergraduate Medical Education Board, an autonomous Board of the Commission.

2. The above assessment report alongwith the data available on AEBAS and HMIS including CCTV footage was considered in Under Graduate Medical Education Board (UGMEB) and certain deficiencies was noted. The same was communicated to the college authorities vide UGMEB's letter dated 13.06.2023 for compliance.

3. Since the response from Employees State Insurance Corporation Medical College, Chennai, Tamil Nadu was not received, an opportunity of personal hearing was given to the college authorities on 27.06.2023.

4. After hearing the college authorities and careful consideration of the facts, it has been decided by the UGMEB that Employees State Insurance Corporation Medical College, Chennai, Tamil Nadu is granted **one year** Continuation of Recognition of MBBS qualification. However, they shall apply afresh for Continuation of Recognition in 2024.

5. Accordingly, the approval of the competent authority in UGMEB is hereby conveyed for grant of **CONTINUATION OF RECOGNITION FOR ONE YEAR** for MBBS degree for 100 students, awarded by Tamil Nadu Dr. MGR Medical University, Chennai in respect of the students being trained at Employees State Insurance Corporation Medical College, Chennai, Tamil Nadu.

6. However, the college authorities are advised to rectify the deficiencies within six months and apply afresh to UGMEB in 2024 for Continuation of Recognition, at least 6(six) month prior to the final examination of MBBS Part-II(Practical) alongwith the requisite fee i.e. Rs. 3.54 lakhs only.
